Safer Internet Day will be celebrated globally to empower children and young people on **Tuesday 6th February 2018** with the theme 'Create, Connect and Share Respect: a better internet starts with you'.

It is organised in the UK by the **UK Safer Internet Centre** (www.saferinternet.org.uk), a partnership of three leading charities: Childnet, the Internet Watch Foundation and SWGfL.



Each year hundreds of organisations organise activities in support of the day. Over **1,600 supporters** were involved in Safer Internet Day 2017, from schools and police, to companies and NGOs.

Collectively, we achieve a huge impact, reaching **42% of UK children** and **23% of UK parents** on SID2017, growing their confidence and inspiring a national conversation about these issues.
